Tamar Action Grants

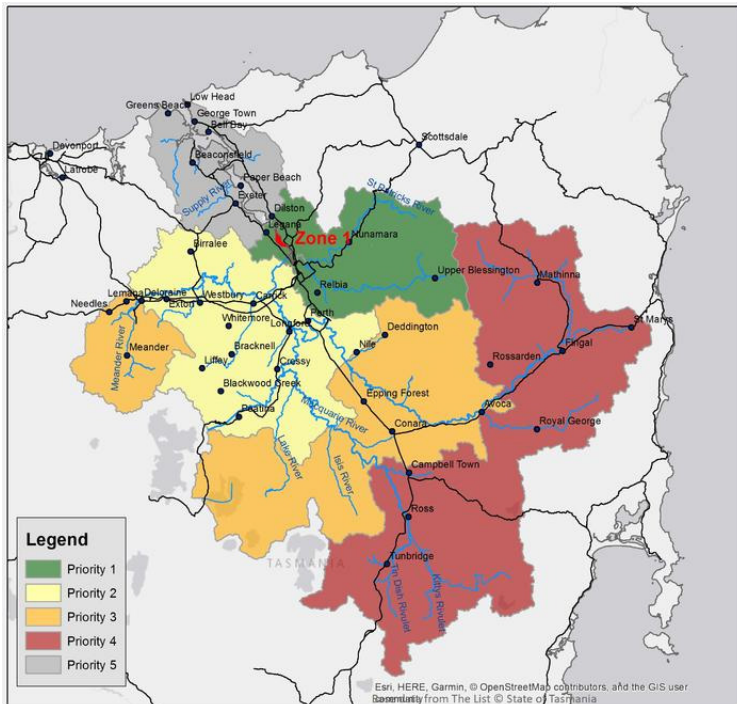


Are you a grazier or dairy farmer in one of the priority areas?

The Tamar Action Grants are now available to support eligible landholders to improve waterway health by restricting stock access and improving effluent management on dairy farms. Projects can be one to five years and include multiple sites.

Funding is available for:

- Waterway fencing and revegetation
- Alternative stock water
- Stock crossings
- Effluent management
